

Location: 2275 Duckabush Road, Brinnon, WA 98320

☐ from JBLM: [1.5 hrs] Take I-5 South to US-101 North to Brinnon, and turn LEFT onto

☐ from NB Kitsap: [1.5 hrs] Take WA-3 North across the Hood Canal to WA-104 West, to US-101=

South through Brinnon, and turn RIGHT onto Duckabush Rd – 2.3 miles to Camp.

☐ From NAS Whidbey: [2 hrs] take ferry to Port Townsend, then WA-20 to US-101 south

• You may reserve a bed inside the lodge through Brinnon, and turn RIGHT onto Duckabush Rd – 2.3 miles to Camp.

☐ There is NO (OR LIMITED) cell phone reception at The Refuge. Plan accordingly.
